

## Walk ALS Down East FAQ's

May 11, 2024 8:30am ECU - Dowdy Ficklen Stadium (Gate 5) 100 Ficklen Dr. Greenville NC

What time does the Walk start? Registration opens at 8:30 am, Opening Ceremonies begin at 9:45am and we walk at 10:00 am. Most people arrive between 8:30 and 9:00am to enjoy the pre-walk activities.

**How long is the Walk route?** The route is approximately 2 miles through the neighborhoods surrounding the stadium.

**Is there a fee to participate?** There is no fee to participate but we encourage all participants to help us fundraise as much as possible!

**Do I get a t-shirt?** Walk T-shirts will be available for registered participants to pick up on Walk Day while supplies last at the T-Shirt tent!

**Can I turn in donations on Walk Day?** YES! Collect all cash and check donations and bring them to Registration area. We can also take credit cards!

Can participants register on the day of the Walk? YES! Participants can register online at any time, and on Walk Day at the Registration area.

Where can I send my check donations before and after Walk Day? Send checks made out to ALS United North Carolina to 4 N. Blount St, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27601. Be sure to write your Team Name and/or your name on the memo line.

Will corporate matches and donations be accepted after the walk? YES! Corporate matches and additional donations will be accepted for several months after the walk.

May I bring my dog? YES! Leashed dogs are always welcome, and please be prepared to pick up after your pet.

**Is the Walk rain or shine?** YES! Keep an eye on the weather and come prepared to walk rain or shine!

Is there food at the walk? No, unfortunately we will not have food available at the event, however we are working on a few partnerships for "Dine to Donates" in town following the walk, if you and your family plan to go out for lunch please visit one of those restaurants.
