

Walk ALS Triangle FAQ's APRIL 20, 2024 8:30am Downtown Raleigh, Halifax Mall 300 N. Salisbury St.

What time does the Walk start? Registration opens at 8:30 am, Opening Ceremonies begin at 9:30 and we walk at 10:00 am. Most people arrive between 8:30 and 9:00am to enjoy the pre-walk activities out on the lawn.

How long is the Walk route? The route is approximately 2 miles through downtown Raleigh. We will walk on a closed course, the Raleigh Police will be assisting with road closures.

Is there a fee to participate? There is no fee to participate but we encourage all participants to help us fundraise as much as possible!

Do I get a t-shirt? Walk T-shirts will be available for registered participants to pick up at our office in Raleigh during the week of 4/15-4/19, and on Walk Day while supplies last!

Can I turn in donations on Walk Day? YES! Collect all cash and check donations and bring them to Registration area. We can also take credit cards!

Can participants register on the day of the Walk? YES! Participants can register online at any time, and on Walk Day at the Registration area.

Where can I send my check donations before and after Walk Day? Send checks made out to ALS United North Carolina to 4 N. Blount St, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27601. Be sure to write your Team Name and/or your name on the memo line.

Will corporate matches and donations be accepted after the walk? YES! Corporate matches and additional donations will be accepted for several months after the walk.

May I bring my dog? YES! Leashed dogs are always welcome, and please be prepared to pick up after your pet.

Is the Walk rain or shine? YES! Keep an eye on the weather and come prepared to walk rain or shine!

Can I bring a tent? YES! A pop up tent is a great meeting place and provides protection from sun and rain. Only sandbags are allowed to tie down on Halifax Mall, no stakes please. Feel free to bring camping chairs, snacks, etc. No alcohol will be permitted.

Is there food at the walk? YES! We're excited to have Che Empanadas Food Truck on site this year, they will have breakfast and lunch items available for purchase.

What is the THEME this year? We're walking "Hollywood Style" in 2024 to continue to shine a spotlight on the need for CURE! Many teams and walkers will dress as their favorite movie characters, or glammed up and "red-carpet-ready"! Others will wear coordinated team t-shirts that they've printed on their own. All are encouraged to be comfortable and have fun with it!
