

Walk ALS Wilmington FAQ's

October 19, 2024 8:30am Long Leaf Park Pavilion #5 314 Pine Grove Dr.

What time does the Walk start? Registration opens at 8:30 am, Opening Ceremonies begin around 9:30 and we walk at 10:00 am. Most people arrive between 8:30 and 9:00am to enjoy the pre-walk activities and live music.

How long is the Walk route? The route is approximately 1.25 miles long, along the paved walking trail throughout Long Leaf Park.

Is there a fee to participate? There is no fee to participate but we encourage all participants to help us fundraise as much as possible!

Do I get a t-shirt? Walk T-shirts will be available at the T-Shirt Tent on walk day for registered participants who raise at least \$25.

Can I turn in donations on Walk Day? YES! Collect all cash and check donations and bring them to Registration area. We can also take credit cards!

Can participants register on the day of the Walk? YES! Participants can register online at any time, and on Walk Day at the Registration area.

Where can I send my check donations before and after Walk Day? Send checks made out to ALS United North Carolina to 4 N. Blount St, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27601. Be sure to write your Team Name and/or your name on the memo line.

Will corporate matches and donations be accepted after the walk? YES! Corporate matches and additional donations will be accepted for several months after the walk.

May I bring my dog? Yes! Leashed dogs are always welcome, be sure to visit our "Pup Tent" hospitality area with water bowls and treats. Please be respectful and make sure to pick up after your pet. Don't forget there is a prize for Best Dressed Pet!

Is the Walk rain or shine? YES! Keep an eye on the weather and come prepared to walk rain or shine! But we have ordered SUNSHINE after last years RAIN!

Should I bring a tent? Tents are optional. The Tent area will be in a designated area near the pavilion, feel free to bring camping chairs, snacks, etc. **No alcohol will be permitted.**

What is the THEME this year? We're walking "Hollywood Style" in 2024 to continue to shine a spotlight on the need for CURE! Many teams and walkers will dress as their favorite movie characters, or glammed up and "red-carpet-ready"! Others will wear coordinated team t-shirts that they've printed on their own.
